If you have a group, they'll even take you on a guided tour, testing the capacity of

the Segway (and its riders) up and down hills, weaving through pedestrian traffic along Venice Beach, and pointing out significant landmarks along the way. The Segway is not for those who experience stage fright—glaring eyes and not-so-clever comments will plague your journey. If you like attention, this tour's for you.
